 - Innovation/advancement of/within the profession.
- Current CIRI National Directors and members of the Fellows Selection Committee are not eligible for nomination.

- Nominations are accepted from CIRI members; members may also self-nominate.

- The Fellows Selection Committee will select the class of new CIRI Fellows based on the criteria above.
- The CIRI Board must approve all Fellow candidates proposed by the Fellows Selection Committee.
